

How to Comply with Harbourfront Centre's Mandatory Vaccination Policy

In response to the Ontario Government's requirement that individuals provide proof of being fully vaccinated in order to attend performances, events and access restaurants, Harbourfront Centre has introduced a mandatory vaccination policy for all of its venues and facilities. This policy applies to all individuals wishing to access Harbourfront Centre including contractors.

In accordance with the terms of your agreement with Harbourfront Centre, you are required to comply with all of Harbourfront Centre's COVID-19 policies and procedures.

In order to facilitate your entrance into our building, please ensure you adhere to the following COVID-19 safety requirements:

- As of September 22nd, it is the responsibility of the contractor to ensure that all personnel accessing the site are fully vaccinated* against COVID-19. **Any individual who fails to disclose their vaccination status to you or who is not fully vaccinated will not be permitted in any Harbourfront Centre building**, unless an exemption is permitted under the Ontario Human Rights Code and the exemption is substantiated with documentation acceptable to Harbourfront Centre. This information must be communicated to your HC Contact.
- *Fully vaccinated means having received a COVID-19 vaccine series approved by Health Canada. For example, a two-dose series of an mRNA vaccine and/or AstraZeneca; or one dose of Johnson & Johnson.
- Proof of vaccination means providing documentation to you that verifies receipt of a vaccination series approved by the Province of Ontario and Health Canada. For example, Ontario's vaccination receipt that is issued at the time of vaccination.
- In addition to the vaccination requirement, all individuals are required to continue to comply with applicable health and safety measures to reduce the hazard of COVID-19, including adhering to Harbourfront Centre's venue access controls, wearing a mask or face covering as required by Harbourfront Centre, using PPE where applicable, maintaining appropriate physical distancing and self-monitoring for potential COVID-19 symptoms.
- Failure to adhere to Harbourfront Centre's vaccination policy may result in the immediate cancellation of the contract.
