




SAILING COURSES AND INSTRUCTION

Harbourfront Centre Sailing & Powerboating is an internationally recognized Sail Canada Centre of Excellence in Training Facility, offering practical, on-water experience.



BASIC SAILING

INTRO TO SAILING

2hrs \$140

If you've never been on a boat before, you may wish to try one of our introductory experiences before you embark on an entire course. Try our Introduction to Sailing program, and have one of our professional instructors show you the ropes. Spend two hours at Toronto's beautiful harbour and you will see what a fun and adventurous activity sailing is.

If you decide you would like to further your sailing skills, you have the opportunity to credit 50% of your Introductory Course to a Basic Course, which you can then use to gain Sail Canada certification.

SAIL CANADA BASIC CRUISING

28hrs \$785

On-the-water experience is the best way to build basic boat handling, sail theory and safety techniques. Smaller custom-designed keelboats make learning and building confidence in your skills easier. This course is the first level of four graduated Sail Canada programs designed to equip you for ocean passages. Course graduates receive internationally recognized certification.

DINGHY SAILING

We have a wide-ranging Dinghy fleet at Harbourfront Centre Sailing & Powerboating, which includes many 420 Performance Racing Dinghies, Hobies, Picos,RS Zests and Fevas.

*Note that certain dinghy maneuvers involve getting wet, so bring a change of clothes.

SAIL CANADA BASIC DINGHY SAILING - CANSAIL 1&2

24hrs \$585

This course is designed for complete beginners to dinghy sailing and those wishing to improve their skills and develop their experience. Based on the nationally recognized Sail Canada CANSail 1 and 2 standard, this course is on board our RS Zests, Fevas and Laser Picos. This fun and challenging course will introduce fundamental sailing concepts such as direction and balance.

SAIL CANADA INTERMEDIATE DINGHY – CANSAIL 3&4

24hrs \$595

Harbourfront Centre Sailing & Powerboating's Intermediate Dinghy standard is designed for students who have achieved their CANSail 1 and 2 levels and want to learn advanced sailing skills. This course will gain you CANSail 3 and 4 accreditation and includes training in advanced boat handling, boat acceleration, racing fundamentals, sail theory and spinnaker work. We encourage those that attain this level to join the club as a member and enjoy a season of on-water adventure with the fantastic backdrop of Toronto's world-class skyline.



ONLINE THEORY REFRESHER COURSES

BASIC CRUISING THEORY

8hrs, Two Saturdays 9am–1pm \$255

This Basic Cruising online refresher course is designed for students to improve and retrain their knowledge of the theory component of this Sail Canada standard. This course includes comprehensive theory on many aspects, including rules of the road, knot tying, safe anchoring, weather, coping with emergencies and nautical charts. It is conducted off-season with a live instructor to teach and assist students throughout. This course is ideal for those that need to prepare for the theory exam or simply want to refresh their knowledge before the season starts.



BASIC POWER THEORY

8hrs, Two Saturdays 9am-1pm \$255

The Basic Power online refresher course is for students that want to reeducate their understanding of the Basic Power theory modules of the Sail Canada standard. A live instructor will guide and teach students through a wide-ranging approach, including trouble shooting motors, preventative maintenance, towing, selecting an anchorage, weather, determining safe loads, safety equipment and safe refueling. This course is ideal for those looking to improve their safe practice knowledge to assist with operating their boat and those who want to prepare for their theory exam.

Please note that Sail Canada requires Basic Cruising and Power students to complete the theory exam within one year of passing their practical exam to gain the complete standard and certification. Those students that fall outside of this one-year completion cycle must re-take their practical. If you would like more information about this, please call our offices.

BEYOND THE BASICS

SAIL CANADA INTERMEDIATE **CRUISING**

5 days, live-aboard \$1,385

This five-day live-aboard course is for the Basic Cruising graduate or sailor with equivalent experience. You will perform controlled sailing maneuvers. prepare meals aboard and pilot the vessels (both as skipper and crew) into an unfamiliar harbour or anchorage. Upon completion, you will be qualified for the internationally recognized Sail Canada Intermediate Standard, the recommended minimum certification for bareboat chartering.

BAREBOAT SKIPPER & INTERNATIONAL **CERTIFICATE OF COMPETENCY (ICC)**

3hrs, \$525

On completion of the Intermediate Cruising course, students have the opportunity to add on the Bareboat Skipper exam, and upon successful completion of this, students will also qualify to receive the International Certificate of Competency certification. Prerequisites include both Basic and Intermediate Coastal Navigation, a VHF License plus the written exam. The pricing includes the exam and the IYT processing fee (ICC Certificate)

NAVIGATION COURSES

SAIL CANADA COASTAL **NAVIGATION**

A comprehensive program designed to develop navigation skills.

basic coastal navigation 19hrs \$455

The course includes the fundamentals of navigation and how to read a chart plus how to plot a course. It includes a Chart I/C 9997, Chart #1 which contains Aids to Navigation, navigation instruments and their use plus how to plot a course.

intermediate coastal navigation 19hrs \$375

The course builds on your knowledge gained in Basic Coastal Navigation and teaches the Running Fix and how to cope with Set & Drift. It also builds on your knowledge of Tides and Currents and takes into account how to calculate the scope required in a tidal anchorage.

INTERNATIONAL YACHT TRAINING

Harbourfront Centre Sailing & Powerboating offers the IYT Bareboat Skipper and Yachtmaster Certification with International Yacht Training Worldwide. Successful candidates will be awarded a prestigious "Master of Yachts 200 Tonnes" Certificate of Competency - a commercial endorsement for operating power or sailing vessels for those wishing

to become professional yachters. The prerequisite for the commercial version of the course is STCW 2010 (Standards in Training, Certification and Watchkeeping) as of 2010, which in Ontario is only available at Georgian College in Owen Sound. To work on a commercial vessel at any level you must take STCW 2010.

INTERNATIONAL **MASTER OF YACHTS** (MOY) LIMITED (OFFSHORE) 200 TONNE

offshore theory 50hrs \$2.225

This course is for a knowledgeable crew with sufficient on-the-water experience. The IYT Master of Yachts 200 Tonne - Limited (Offshore) Certificate is a commercial 200 Tonne Masters Certificate of Competency for operating vessels, sail or power, up to 150 nautical miles from a safe haven.



INTERNATIONAL **MASTER OF YACHTS** (MOY) UNLIMITED **200 TONNE**

unlimited ocean theory 42hrs \$1.995

To gain the IYT Master of Yachts 200 Tonne - Unlimited (Ocean) Certification, a theory session must be successfully completed. The theory portion comprises a 48-hour classroom session which includes Celestial Navigation, pilot planning and passage planning.

POWERBOATING COURSES AND INSTRUCTION

INTRODUCTION TO **POWERBOATING**

1.5hrs \$130

This course is to educate beginner boaters to make educated decisions regarding boat ownership and usage. Though no certificate is issued, the session provides hands-on experience and builds confidence with time aboard and in the driver's seat. This introduction gives an overview of some of the basics in the Power Boating syllabus. After an introductory talk on equipment and personal safety, we will head to the boat to familiarize ourselves with the controls and operation. Some confined space turning, docking and slow speed maneuvers will give insight into confident boating.

The overall goal of the Sailing CIT program is to train future Sailing Instructors and Camp Counsellors in the day-to-day operations of sailing. This program requires participants to experience both on-land and on-water camp procedures and situations and evaluate their decision-making within those environments.

BOAT LICENSES

PLEASURE CRAFT **OPERATORS CARD** (PCOC)

\$55

\$45 for HCSP students and members. Textbook is an additional fee.

Government legislation requires that all operators of any power-driven vessel - even a Personal Water Craft (PWC) - obtain a Pleasure Craft Operator Card (PCOC). If you are renting a boat, our 'Rental Boat Safety Checklist' must be completed before embarking.

complete an accredited course and carry the card

Once you have successfully obtained a Canadian Coast Guard accredited Pleasure Craft Operator Card issued by Sail Canada you must carry it with you at all times while operating a power-driven vessel or sail boat (much like a driver's license).

competency regulations

All youth born after April 1, 1983 must carry the card.

Since September 15, 2002, anyone operating a powered recreational vessel less than four meters (13 feet) in length (including personal watercraft) must obtain a Pleasure Craft Operator Card.

As of September 15, 2009, all powerdriven vessel operators must obtain a Pleasure Craft Operator Card.

TORONTO HARBOUR LICENSE

3hrs \$160

To operate any power-driven vessel in Toronto Harbour, you must have a Harbour License. This course will give you the theoretical knowledge you need to be successful and includes a written and practical test. Previous powerboating experience is required.

VHF-DSC LICENSE




