We customize our events to suit the specific objectives of your company. Let our staff know your specific event goal, and we will seek to tailor your experience accordingly.

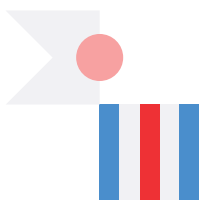

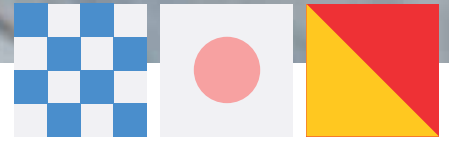

WHAT TO BRING

Special equipment is not necessary. We will supply safety equipment including an approved Personal Flotation Device (PFD). In addition, we recommend you bring the following for your increased comfort and pleasure:

- Hat
- Sunglasses

- Light waterproof jacket and pants
- Additional thin layers of clothing
- Light non-marking shoes
- Most importantly, bring your enthusiasm and sense of adventure and be prepared to have a great time!

HOW TO BOOK

To book your event, we require your group size, event date and timing and the category of the event that you wish to book. Once availability is confirmed, we will send your company a quote. To book your experience, we require a 50% deposit at the time of booking, after which you will receive a confirmation email. The remaining balance will be due 48 hours before your event start date. CANCELLATION POLICY

In the event of thunderstorms or winds over 20 knots, we reserve the right to postpone the event, as it would be deemed unsafe under these weather conditions. An alternative date can be booked within the season. If the client decides to cancel the event with no recourse to book another date/time, we will refund 50% of the total event and retain the 50% deposit.
