# **DINGHY SAILING**

# **INTRO TO DINGHY SAILING**

# 3 hrs \$180

This course is a great way to dip your toes into the world of dinghy sailing. Designed for those without sailing experience, our instructors will introduce you to the basics of sailing and guide you through your first on-water sail! Spending three hours on the water in downtown Toronto is the perfect opportunity to get a feel for what dinghy sailing is all about.

If you would like to further your dinghy sailing skills, you can credit 50% of the cost of your Introductory Course to a CANSail 1/2 Course, which you can then use to gain Sail Canada certification.

# **BASIC DINGHY -**CANSAIL 1 & 2 24 hrs \$595

This course teaches and strengthens essential skills: the building blocks of sailing. It is designed for both complete beginners and those wishing to improve their skills. Based on the CANSail 1 and 2 standards, this course is on board our RS Zests and Fevas. This fun and challenging course will introduce fundamental sailing concepts such as direction and balance.

Please note: due to the amount of practice required to develop these skills, we cannot guarantee that students will receive both CANSail 1 and 2 in one session. We recommend taking this course twice to maximize your chance of gaining both levels.



# INDEPENDENT **DINGHY SAILING -**CANSAIL 2+

# 6 hrs \$195

This course is for students who have completed their CANSail 2 and wish to sail independently outside classes. It allows students to get more experience on the water while also teaching strategies for high-wind sailing, selfrescue and launching and docking in varied wind conditions. Successful competition of this course will allow students to join our club as members or rent our dinghies.

# INTERMEDIATE **DINGHY – CANSAIL** 3&4

# 28 hrs \$695

This course is all about speed, focusing on racing and high-performance sailing. Building upon CANSail 1 and 2 skills, it teaches students everything they need to take their sailing to the next level. Students will learn advanced boat handling, boat acceleration, racing fundamentals, sail theory and more. This course is a step up from CANSail 2; students will be required to sail in various weather conditions and reach a high standard of sailing to achieve a level.

Please note: due to the amount of practice required to develop these skills, we cannot guarantee that students will receive both CANSail 3 and 4 in one session. To maximize your chance of success at this level, we recommend students gain additional sailing experience after completing their CANSail 2 before beginning this course.

We deliver two courses to suit your needs, as well as Own Boat Tuition for boat owners who wish to train on their own vessel.



# INTRODUCTION TO POWERBOATING

# 1.5hrs \$150

This course is designed to give beginner boaters an opportunity to gain experience with powerboating and provides an overview of some of the content taught in the Basic Power course. Though no certificate is issued, the session provides hands-on experience and builds confidence with time aboard and in the driver's seat.

After an introductory talk on equipment and personal safety, we will head to the boat to familiarize ourselves with the controls and operation. Some confined space turning, docking and slow speed maneuvers will give insight into confident boating.

# OWN BOAT

# \$80-\$180 per hour

We can provide a qualified instructor to teach you the ropes on your sail or powerboat. Prices range from \$80-\$180 per hour, with potential travel costs depending on the location of your boat from our base in downtown Toronto.

# SAIL CANADA BASIC POWER COURSE

# 18hrs \$695

This course focuses on building confidence and providing core skills for safe and competent outboard and inboard operation. It focuses primarily on safety, docking, slow and high-speed maneuvers, and you will learn proficient techniques across several other areas.

# **BEYOND THE BASICS**

# SAIL CANADA INTERMEDIATE CRUISING

# 5 days, live-aboard \$1,585

This five-day live-aboard course is for the Basic Cruising graduate or sailor with equivalent experience. You will perform controlled sailing maneuvers, prepare meals aboard and pilot the vessels (both as skipper and crew) into an unfamiliar harbour or anchorage. Upon completion, you will be qualified for the internationally recognized Sail Canada Intermediate Standard, the recommended minimum certification for bareboat chartering.

# Requirements before taking the standard:

- Basic Cruising Standard or equivalent experience
- ROC(M) VHF with DSC Radio License endorsement
- Pleasure Craft Operator's Card (or equivalent)
- Sail Canada Basic Coastal Navigation Standard or Coastal Navigation Standard

# Recommended before taking the standard:

- Recognized Standard First Aid and CPR certificate
- Sail Canada Intermediate Coastal Navigation Standard

## Note: to maximize the likelihood of completing the Intermediate Cruising Standard, a student should:

- Have experience as a skipper of at least ten-day sails (or equivalent).
- Be able to consistently demonstrate the skills learned in the Basic Cruising Standard and the Basic Coastal Navigation Standard.

# INTERNATIONAL CERTIFICATE OF COMPETENCY ICC BAREBOAT SKIPPER

# 3hrs, \$550

On completion of the Intermediate Cruising course, students have the opportunity to add on the Bareboat Skipper exam, and upon successful completion of this, students will also qualify to receive the International Certificate of Competency certification. Prerequisites include both Basic and Intermediate Coastal Navigation, a VHF License plus the written exam. The pricing includes the exam and the IYT processing fee (ICC & Bareboat Skipper Certificates).

# SAIL CANADA COASTAL NAVIGATION

A comprehensive program designed to develop navigation skills.

# basic coastal navigation 19hrs \$495

The course includes the fundamentals of navigation and how to read a chart plus how to plot a course. It includes a Chart I/C 9997, Chart #1 which contains Aids to Navigation, navigation instruments and their use plus how to plot a course.

# intermediate coastal navigation 16hrs \$395

The course builds on your knowledge gained in Basic Coastal Navigation and teaches the Running Fix and how to cope with Set & Drift. It also builds on your knowledge of Tides and Currents and takes into account how to calculate the scope required in a tidal anchorage.



Harbourfront Centre Sailing & Powerboating offers the IYT Bareboat Skipper and Yachtmaster Certification with International Yacht Training Worldwide.

Successful candidates will be awarded a prestigious "Master of Yachts 200 Tonnes" Certificate of Competency – a commercial endorsement for operating power or sailing vessels for those wishing to become professional yachters. The prerequisite for the commercial version of the course is STCW 2010 (Standards in Training, Certification and Watchkeeping) as of 2010, which in Ontario is only available at Georgian College in Owen Sound. To work on a commercial vessel at any level you must take STCW 2010.





# INTERNATIONAL MASTER OF YACHTS (MOY) LIMITED (OFFSHORE) 200 TONNE

# JUNIOR SEADOGS

# ages 6–9 yrs \$425 (4 days) \$480 (5 days)

This program requires participants to experience both on-land and on-water camp procedures and situations and evaluate their decision-making within those environments.

# **BOAT LICENSES**

# PLEASURE CRAFT OPERATORS CARD (PCOC)

# \$55

# \$45 for HCSP students and members. Textbook is an additional fee.

Government legislation requires that all operators of any power-driven vessel – even a Personal Water Craft (PWC) – obtain a Pleasure Craft Operator Card (PCOC). If you are renting a boat, our 'Rental Boat Safety Checklist' must be completed before embarking.

# complete an accredited course and carry the card

Once you have successfully obtained a Canadian Coast Guard accredited Pleasure Craft Operator Card issued by Sail Canada you must carry it with you at all times while operating a power-driven vessel or sail boat (much like a driver's license).

# competency regulations

All youth born after April 1, 1983 must carry the card.

Since September 15, 2002, anyone operating a powered recreational vessel less than four meters (13 feet) in length (including personal watercraft) must obtain a Pleasure Craft Operator Card.

As of September 15, 2009, all powerdriven vessel operators must obtain a Pleasure Craft Operator Card.

# TORONTO HARBOUR LICENSE

# 3hrs \$160

To operate any power-driven vessel in Toronto Harbour, you must have a Harbour License. This course will give you the theoretical knowledge you need to be successful and includes a written and practical test. Previous powerboating experience is required.

# VHF-DSC RADIO OPERATORS LICENSE




To rent a powerboat, you must be over 21 with a current driver's license or over 18 with a Pleasure Craft Operators Card (PCOC). Our knowledgeable staff give a full safety briefing on all rentals. Ask our staff on how to obtain a PCOC. To rent a dinghy, you must have completed our Independent Sailing course or hold your CANSail 3 or have equivalent experience. To rent a keelboat, dinghy or large powerboat, please submit your Boating Resumé for approval. The Boating Resume online form can be found on our website.
